


- Connect is an educational platform where you can access your homework and course material.

Guide to problem reporting

Case details

- Title: should be concise and informative.
- Description: clearly describe the issue. How you got to the point where the problem occurred? What you expected to happen if there was no problem? What actually happened, with a description of why this is a problem.
- Comments: Include detailed steps on how to reproduce the problem providing the URL and your log-in details, when appropriate. Include browser name, browser version, operating system and operating system version. If possible, include a screenshot of the problem.
